RENEWAL INFORMATION

Awards are renewable annually, provided that the student's academic achievement is at a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 or equivalent ("C"). Renewal forms and a complete transcript* must be on file at the Foundation office on or before July 15. Absence of either a renewal form and/or transcript may result in the loss of the scholarship for the next award cycle.

If a recipient's cumulative grade point average at his/her current institution falls below a "C" (2.0 or equivalent), or the grade point average for two (2) consecutive semesters or terms falls below a "C", the scholarship will terminate.

All renewals must be sent to The Gerber Foundation, 4747 W 48th St, Ste 153, Fremont MI 49412.

Renewal stipends will be made payable to the college/university listed on the renewal form and mailed to the award recipient. The entire amount of the scholarship stipend for the school year will be paid on or about August 15. Stipends will be sent directly to the student at the address specified on the renewal form, Part A.

Scholarships are to be applied for the purpose of paying for tuition, books, fees, and required equipment only and may not be used for room, board or other expenses. Awardees are reminded that they signed a guaranty agreement to return any scholarship monies received which are not used for the intended purpose.

*A complete transcript is one which contains all of the following, at a minimum. Transcripts/grade reports obtained via the Internet are acceptable as long as they are complete. Otherwise, official transcripts from the school must be furnished.

- 1) Student name
- 2) School, College or University name
- 3) All semesters completed, with course listings, grades for each course, and semester GPA
- 4) Current cumulative GPA
